At a time when the competition for university places continues to make national headlines, we are delighted to announce yet another successful year for our Sixth Form students.

St. Anne's are celebrating a high average UCAS point score of 329 and a very high pass rate again this year, with an extremely impressive 97.9% of Year 13 students passing their A-levels which is an increase on results from this time last year. The number of high-level exam results to celebrate continues with 23.5% of results at either an A or A* grade and an impressive 52.4% of results being achieved at grades A*, A or B.

Notable results include Tayyba Akhter with 2 A* grades and an A who will be studying Physics at Southampton University and Anjolie Chou who achieved an A* and 2 As and is going to Southampton University to study Languages and Contemporary European Studies. Danielle Green, who achieved 3A* grades and will be going to Oxford to study Philosophy and French, had some wise words of advice for future A level students "The most important thing is to love learning. Enjoy what you do and success will follow".
